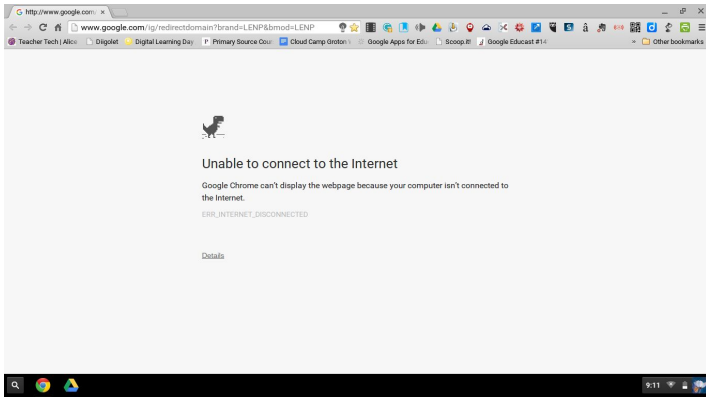
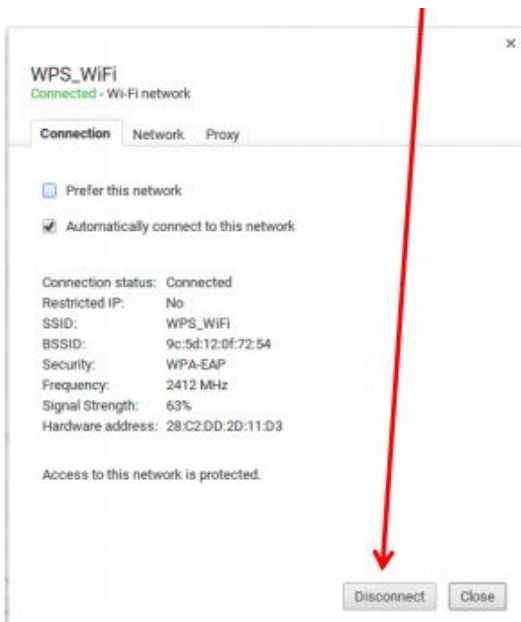
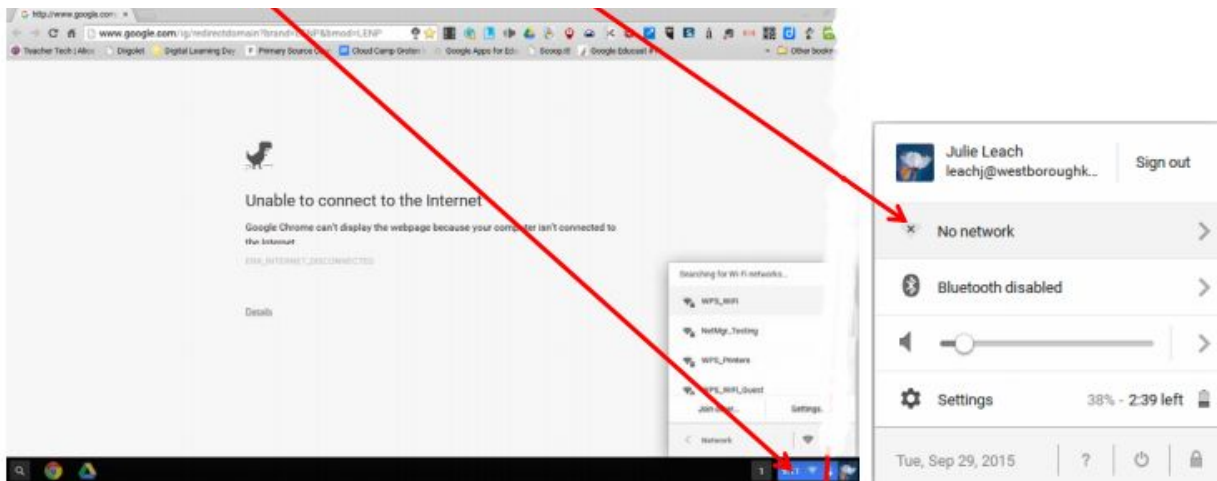


Connecting to WiFi on a Chromebook

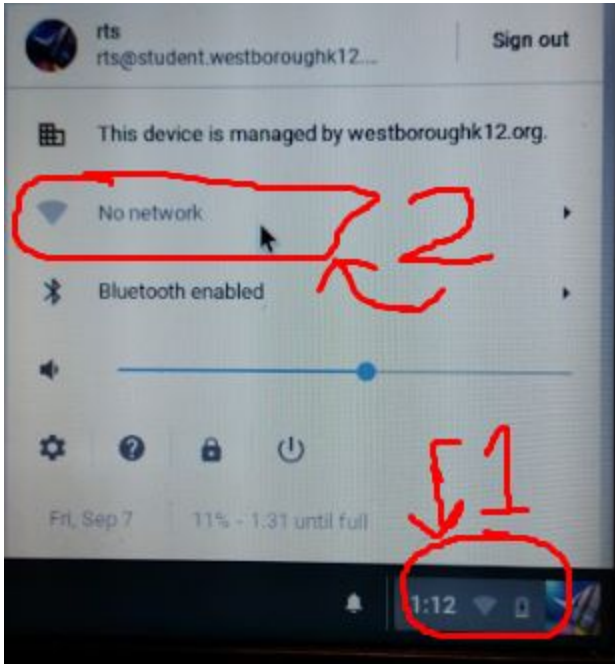
When you turn on your Chromebook for the first time to access the school wifi, you should see this message:



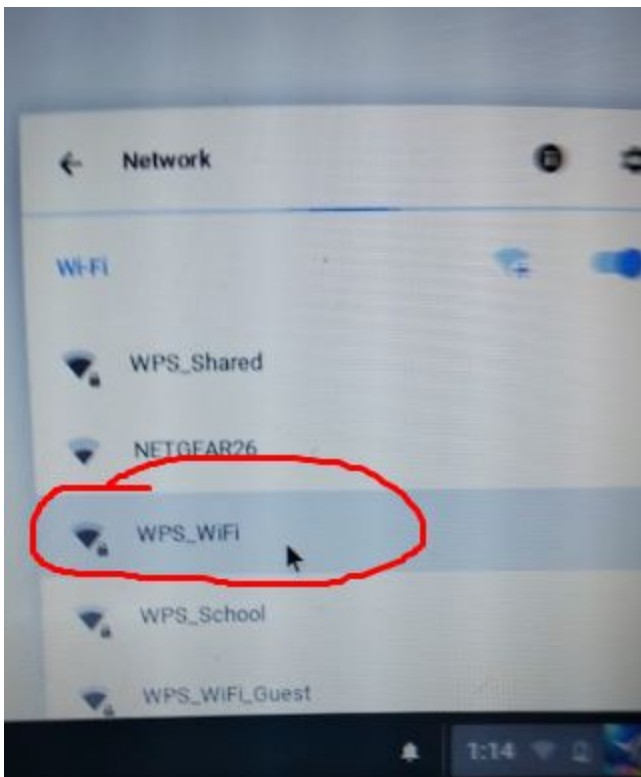
If you don't get this message you will need to disconnect from your home network. To do this, first click the bottom right of your screen on the wifi symbol, then on the button that says the name of your network, and then on disconnect when the dialog box opens up.



Then just go back to the bottom right of your screen and click on the wifi symbol (1) and click on the button that says "no network" (2)




You should now be able to choose WPS_WIFI from the list.



This will open up a window allowing you to connect to the High school's WiFi with the correct information. This information, not including your own personal login credentials for the network, are as follows:

Make sure EAP Method is set to PEAP







Make sure Phase 2 Authentication is set to Automatic





Make sure the Server CA Certificate is set to "Do not check"
