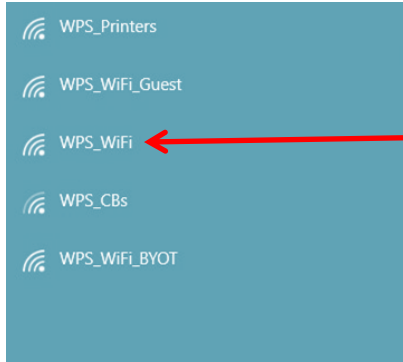

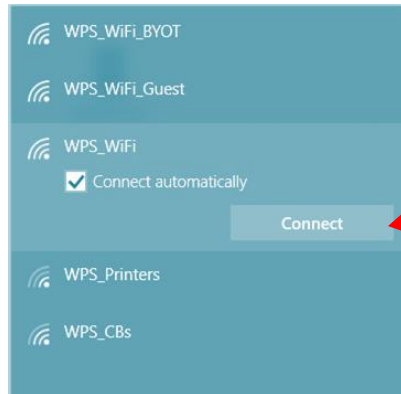

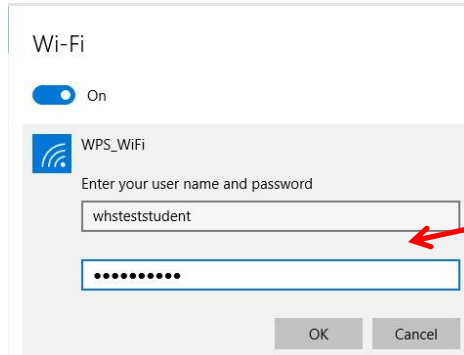
Click on the WiFi icon on the bottom right of the taskbar

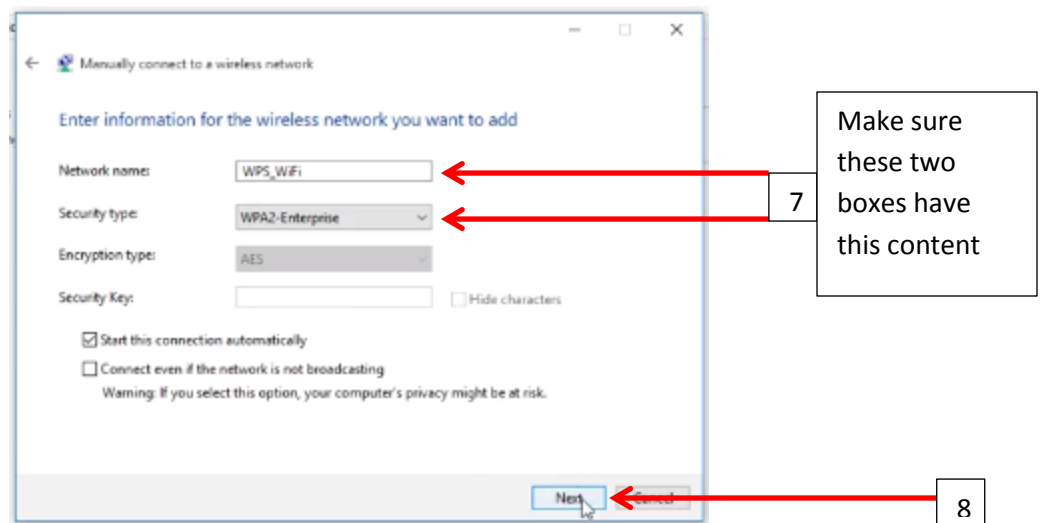
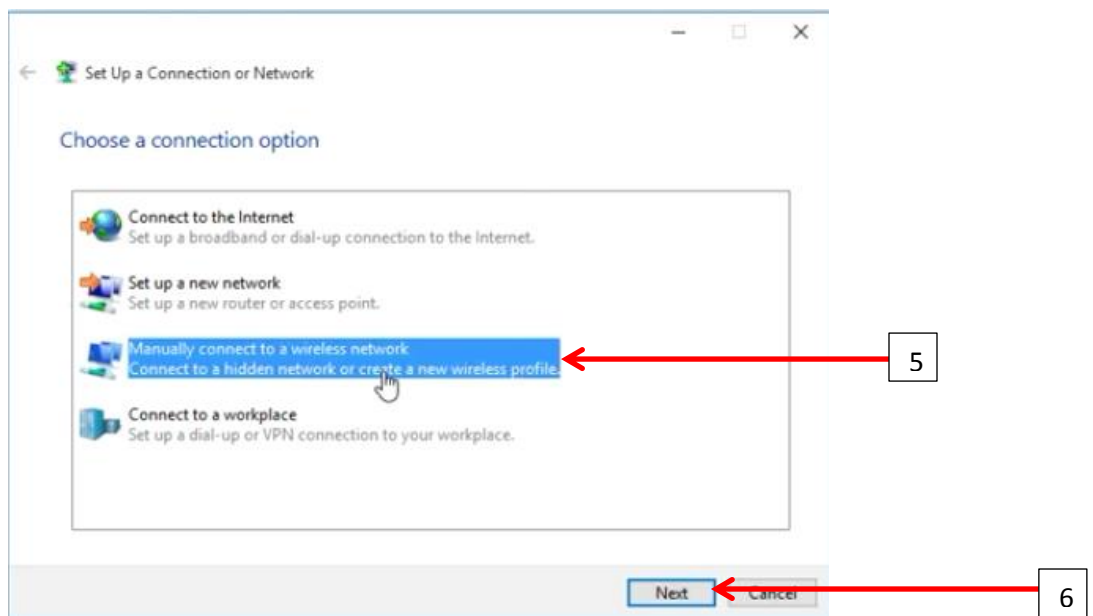
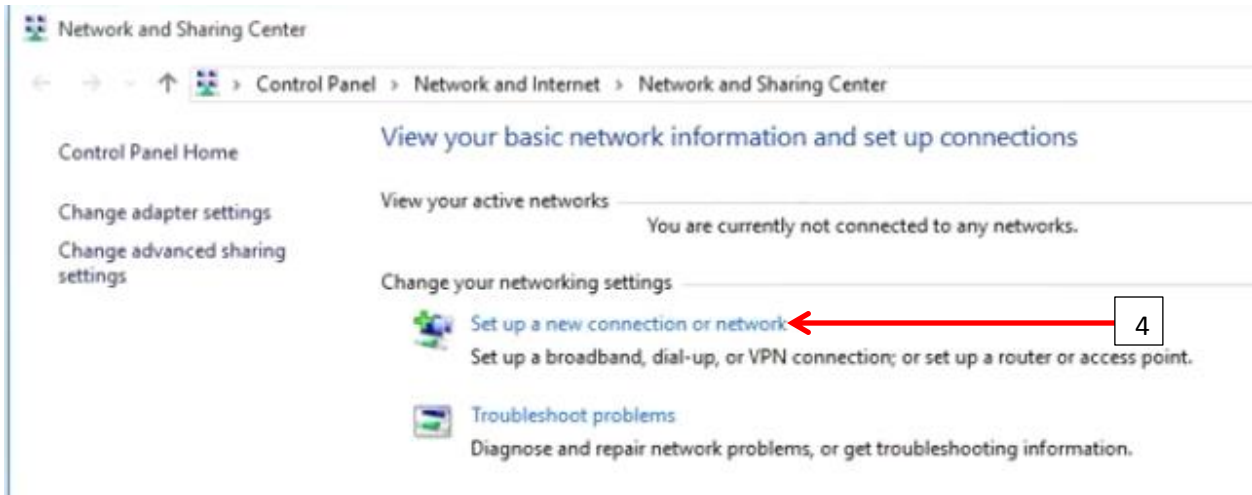
When you turn on your Win10 Laptop for the first time to access the school wifi, you should see this message:

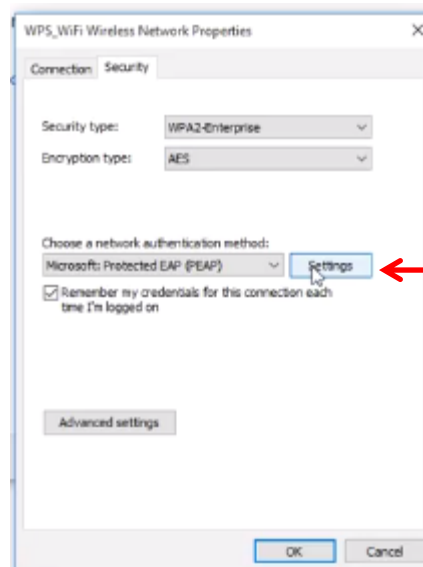
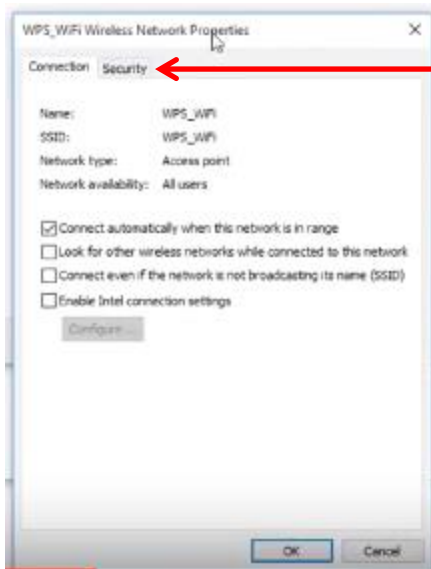
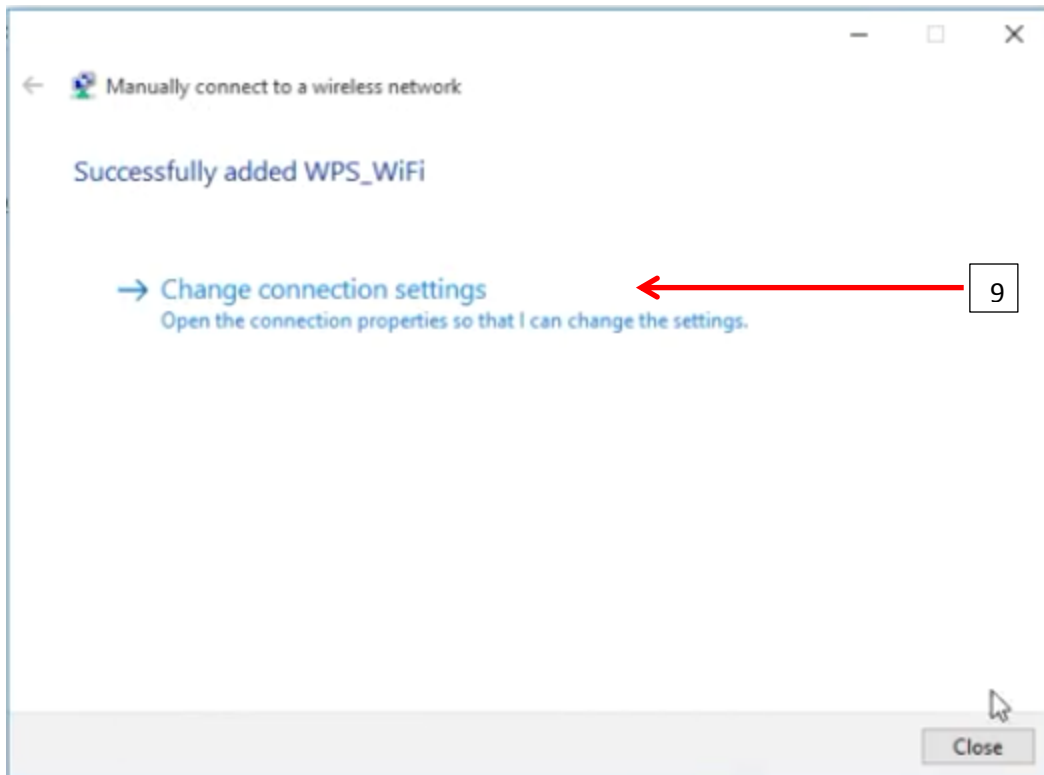


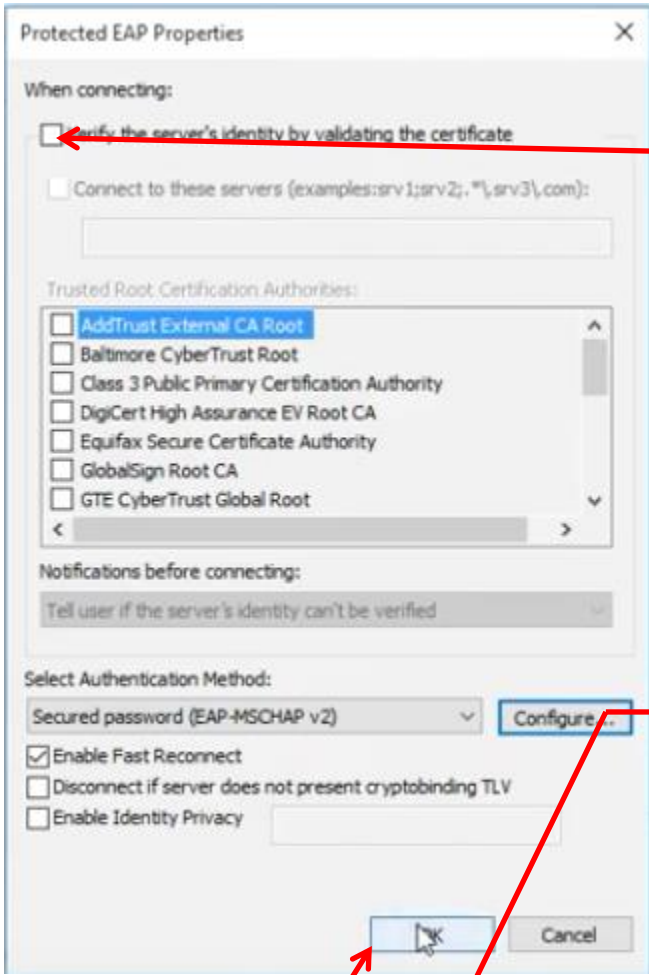
Choose the WiFi icon in the bottom right corner of your screen.

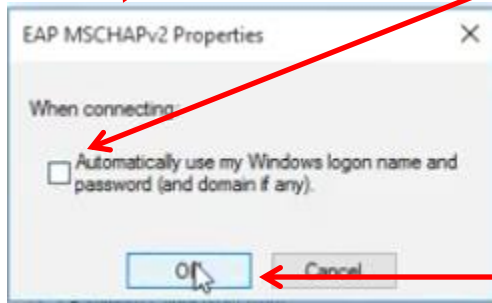

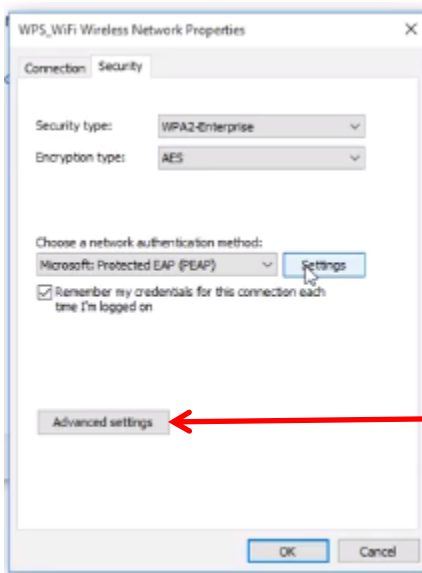

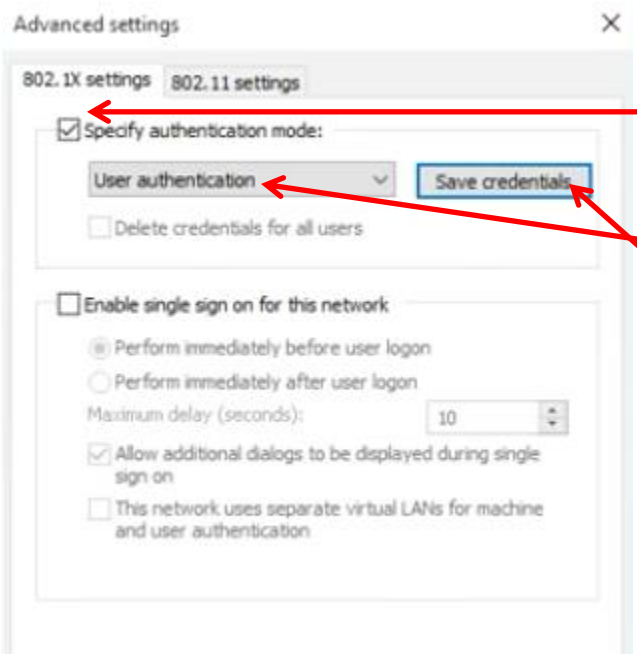
